What is ADWEP?

The Quad County Urban League (QCUL) would like to introduce the Adult and Dislocated Worker Employment Program (ADWEP) funded through the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) of the Kane County Department of Employment and Education (KCDEE). This program is designed to provide participants a paid “working experience” thorough your establishment.

With your help we can provide participants with a minimum of 12 to 26 weeks of paid training in a skilled area.

By participating in this program you will:

- Receive additional on site staff support from ADWEP participants; while providing career/professional training opportunities. Participants will be **paid** through the program budget at no cost to your organization.
- Upon Program completion, your company will have the opportunity to hire the trained participant, with enhanced skills as a temporary, part-time or full-time employee.
- Partner with KCDEE, QCUL and the greater community to empower participants and community residents who are unemployed, underemployed or dislocated to gain valuable experience and re-enter the workforce.

QCUL’s role in ADWEP?

Through this program, QCUL is able to provide participants an opportunity to gain paid “Work Experience.” This program will service residents in Kane and Kendall counties.

Our objective is to provide participants the opportunity to:

- Utilize skills previously gained or acquired in a professional work setting; while obtaining new industry experience.
- Prepare for entry level competitive employment by offering a variety of computer and job skills training.
- Rebuild their morale by offering **paid** “Work Experience” in a challenging economy.

Our overall goal is to merge our services with your influential company to continue trailblazing in community services .

Here at QCUL we understand the **Power in Partnership** and we encourage our local business to help become the change we would like to see in our community.



Your Role in ADWEP

- Worksites are selected based on their ability to provide proper supervision and training during the participant’s scheduled throughout the duration of their training.
- The job description/training plan needs to clearly identify areas of training and tasks that will be learned and performed by the participant during their work experience training .
- The trainer’s/supervisor’s schedule must cover the time period of the participants schedule.
- The trainer/supervisor must attend an orientation to the ADWEP program to be come familiar with the program, purpose and requirements.
